Welcome back to our Home!

While visiting today there are just a few things you need to know in order to continue to keep us healthy.

Visiting Hours

1. Visiting hours are: Tuesday – Wednesday – Thursday 10a – 12n and Sunday 10a – 1130a, 1p – 3p.
2. Visits are limited to 20 minutes. This gives the staff time to transport and clean the visitation area.
3. Outdoor visits are encouraged however in case of cold or rainy weather the visit will be rescheduled as a window visit.

Visitor Health Screening:

1. At this time, visitors under the age of 18 are allowed accompanied by one adult.
2. You are required to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test at the time of the visit. If you choose, you may email the result to dweimer@eshomeny.org
3. You will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms, including temperature check prior to each visit. This screening also includes questions regarding recent travel.
4. Please do not visit if you are coughing, sneezing, nasally congested, short of breath, nauseated, vomiting, have diarrhea or any other symptom of illness.
5. Anyone who does not provide us with a copy of a negative test or fails the health screening will not be allowed to visit.
6. A demographic form is required prior to each visit. Name, physical street address, phone numbers (day and evening), email address and date and time of visit are required. This information will be electronically filed for contact tracing purposes should the need arise.

During the Visit:

7. You are required to wear a face mask at all times while on the premises. The mask must cover your nose and your mouth. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided to you.
8. As much as we want a hug, please don't. We know it's hard to stay 6 feet away but it is for our health!
9. Please wash your hands with the hand sanitizer that is available.
10. If you don't observe any of the above, you will be asked to leave and future in person visits may be in jeopardy.

COVID - 19 Visitation FAQ Sheet

1. Why is the visitation limited to outdoors and only certain hours?

Right now the Department of Health is requiring outdoor visits as an “opening to visitation”. Indoor visits are possible in the near future however the facility is required to have these visits in a well ventilated area of the facility that is not located in a resident care area. We are awaiting renovation areas to be completed before we can offer an indoor area that meets these requirements. Our staff must be available to not only monitor visitors but also to meet the needs of the residents through daily programming of activities such a hallway BINGO, POKENO, Make a Word, etc.

2. I have to have COVID test and since employees are being tested, why can't I be tested prior to the visit?

In order to do test here at the facility, we have in place what is called a CLIA certificate. This certificate does not allow for testing of the community, only for our residents and staff when it involves COVID -19.

3. Where can I have a COVID-19 test performed?

Right now there are two places in the area where the public may be tested for free without symptoms, Griffiss Airport in Rome and Rite Aid on Commercial Drive in New Hartford. The attached list will give you the information needed to make that appointment.

4. Do I need the result before I **schedule** my visit?

It is recommended that you have the result or have been tested when you schedule your visit. This test result is good for 7 days from the date of the test. You **must** present the test result at the time of the visit.

5. Is there a limit on the number of visits per week I can visit?

Yes. In order to give all our residents and family members an opportunity to visit we are asking family members to consider visiting together as opposed to separately. Unfortunately visits will be limited to one a week to accommodate all residents with changes implemented accordingly.

6. How many visitors are allowed at one time?

Due to social distancing and the 10% rule, each resident is only allowed to have two visitors at a time ; one visitor may be under the age of 18 if accompanied by an adult.

7. How do I schedule a visit?

Visits will be scheduled by the Campus Life Department just as other visits have been.
